## 2015 ACSCI Banquet Games and Raffles

## MUG RAFFLE

At the banquet, you can buy an ACSCI Mug for \$20. Each mug contains Raffle Tickets, ranging in value from $\$ 30$ up to $\$ 60$ that can be used on any of the five Table Raffle. No mug contains LESS than $\$ 30$ in Raffle Tickets.

## 50/50 RAFFLE

Tickets are $\$ 5$ each; 3 for $\$ 10 ; 10$ for $\$ 20$. Tickets on sale at 12 noon until drawing just before the Live Auction.

## MYSTERY GUN RAFFLE

Special tickets sell 3 for $\$ 20$ or an ARM LENGTH of tickets for $\$ 30$. The winning ticket is drawn at the end of the evening.

## WALL OF GUNS

Each card in a deck of cards will sell for $\$ 20$. You get half of the card, the other half goes into the pot for a drawing. As soon as the whole deck is sold, a half-card is drawn from the pot. If your half-card matches the one drawn, you get to choose one of the guns on the Wall of Guns. If all cards in a deck are not sold, half of the proceeds for that part of the deck will be awarded in cash. Cards begin selling at 12 noon and decks of cards will be sold during the afternoon and early evening.

## WINE \& GUN CABINET RAFFLE

From Kelsey's Collection, a wine storage cabinet stocked with 15 bottles of wine. The cabinet has a hidden locked gun compartment and artwork by Terry Redlin - 'Flying Free Eagles at Sunset' - on three sides. Each card in deck of cards will sell for $\$ 20$. You get half of the card, the other half goes into the pot for the drawing.

## HEARTH CHEST RAFFLE

From Kelsey's Collection, a hearth box for fireside use to store kindling, newspapers, or collectibles. Chest has artwork by Dave Barnhouse - 'Back Home Again' - on three sides. Dimensions 18 " $\times 12$ " $\times 12$ "; weight 8.5 lbs . Multiple decks of cards may be sold for this raffle. Each card will sell for $\$ 20$. You get half of the card, the other half goes into the pot for the drawing. Proceeds from this raffle will benefit the Hunts for Wounded Warriors program.

## BINGO GAME, NO LOSERS!

You will enjoy the special VIP dinner menu, take home the prizes, and use the raffle tickets for any of the five Table Raffles. But if upon opening the envelope it contains less than $\$ 20$, we will then draw another envelope until there is a winner.
