RULES FOR GAMES AND RAFFLES

TABLE RAFFLES: BIG BORE, PREDATOR, SABLES, WHITETAIL AND YOUNG HUNTER

Place any of the following raffle tickets in the table bucket of your choice: Advance purchased ticket Pack #1 (Red) and Pack #2 (Green) or Special Table Raffle Ticket Pack purchased at banquet (White) or raffle tickets earned by returning your Bingo Cards after the Bingo game ends (Pink).

BINGO GAME, NO LOSERS!

Buy 1 Bingo Card for \$20, 3 Cards for \$50, or 10 Cards for \$100. Prize is either the gun or \$599. This is a Bingo Game but one in which you DO NOT want the number that is being called to appear on your card. If the number called is on your card, you turn in that card for \$20 worth of tickets (2) for entry in the Table Raffles and you are no longer in the game. But as long as the numbers being called DO NOT appear on your card, you are still in the game. The last person with no called number on their card is the Bingo Winner!!

CHAPTER GUN OF THE YEAR RAFFLE

Tickets are \$50 each and only 100 tickets will be sold for this raffle. If all 100 tickets are sold, the drawing will be during the fundraiser. Otherwise, drawing is at the next Chapter meeting after tickets are sold out.

50/50 RAFFLE

Tickets are \$5 each; 3 for \$10; 10 for \$20. Tickets on sale at 1pm and are sold until the drawing in late afternoon.

MYSTERY GUN RAFFLE

Tickets sell 3 for \$20 or an arm's length of tickets for \$30. Drawing for the gun is at the end of the evening.

SPIRITS OF THE HUNT

Basket with a selection of wines, liquors, and distilled beverages. Tickets sell 3 for \$20, or an arm's length of tickets for \$30. Drawing is in the evening.

UN-STICK THE PIG RAFFLE

The game starts with a pig target 'stuck' with 100 knives. To play the game, it's \$25 per knife pull to 'un-stick' the pig. You get one entry or ticket in the drawing for a gun per knife pull and you get to keep the knife. Drawing for the gun prize occurs when all 100 knives are pulled from the pig.

WALL OF GUNS

Cards begin selling at 1pm with decks being sold throughout the day. Each card in a deck of cards will sell for \$25. You get half a card with the other half going in the bucket. Drawing for a gun occurs when all cards in that deck are sold. If your half-card matches the one drawn, you get to choose one gun from the Wall of Guns. Then the next deck of cards will begin selling to start a new game. If all cards in a deck are not sold, half of the proceeds collected for that part of the deck will be awarded in cash and the game ends.



Adirondack - Catskill Chapter SCI Youth Day Program





Shotgunners: We are open to the public every Sunday at 8:30am for trap, skeet, sporting clays and 5-stand rain or shine. There are two Trap fields, three Skeet fields and one Covered Five Stand. All fields are equipped with push button or voice activated automatic traps. For a challenge, try our 18-station Sporting Clays course.

Rifle and Pistol shooters: The Oneonta Sportsmen's Club has two 10-station, fixed bench, outdoor covered shooting ranges and one 10-station, fixed bench heated indoor range. All banquet attendees are entitled to participate in the live auction and bid on items. Attendees are issued a bidder number card in their Check-in Packet (issued when you arrive.) Please have your number card ready and use it when bidding on items. Announcements made at the time of auction take precedence over pre-auction written material. During the live auction, attendees must limit their conversations and direct their attention to the Auctioneer and presentation of auction items.

TERMS OF SALE

- 1. The auctioneer has the final authority on the amount paid for any item and the identity of the purchaser of any item.
 - **DISPUTED BID**: If after the auctioneer declares any item "sold", a contest arises between bidders as to who was the successful bidder, the auctioneer reserves the right to reopen the bidding on the contested item.
- 2. The purchaser must sign a buyer's contract for each item purchased at the time of the sale. Immediately after a successful bid, one of our staff will arrive at your table for this purpose.

 Proof of payment will be required before any items may be claimed or removed from the banquet hall.

 When payment is made, a paid receipt will be issued. All sales are final.
- 4. PAYMENT METHODS ACCEPTED: CASH, CHECK, or CREDIT CARD + 3% MERCHANT FEE. Merchant fee is applied to credit card purchases.
 - ALL SALES ARE FINAL, NO EXCHANGES OR REFUNDS ON ANY ITEM. WE CANNOT GUARANTEE THE SATISFACTION OF THE DONOR OR THE BUYER.
